Because the Agoonoram has been uploaded to the Agoonoree website every day during camp, the full week collection of them will not be sold this year. You can access them when you arrive home after camp!


## Yesterday's Special Events



The patrol has enjoyed swimming and abseiling the most. Lauryn has loved going dancing!


